

THE BEAULIEU SCOW - OPHELIA

Made entirely in wood, Ophelia is based on the traditional Beaulieu design and Lymington scows built by John Claridge. At 11'3" she is a perfect small sailing dinghy for teaching youngsters and is low maintenance with high durability.

The cold moulded hull is constructed by laying Khaya veneers over a temporary jig and then applying two further layers to create a stable but lightweight hull skin. The final veneer, laid fore to aft, gives the appearance of a traditionally planked carvel hull, but without the maintenance headaches, and the varnished bright finish shows off this timber and planking effect. The internal fit out uses various woods including sapele and spruce and includes a foredeck, buoyancy tanks, centreboard case, thwart, and a balanced lug rig.
